

RESOLUTION NO. 21-28

A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (MNDOT) TO ACQUIRE CITY LAND

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) proposes to make certain improvements on a portion of T.H. 86 located in Lakefield (City) under S.P. 3208-19; and

WHEREAS, MnDOT has requested the acquisition of property from the City of Lakefield for temporary easement, permanent easement, or both; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAKEFIELD, MINNESOTA:

1. For and in consideration of the sum of seven thousand nine hundred forty dollars (\$7,940.00) to be paid by the State of Minnesota, Department of Transportation, that the City allows the acquisition of land by direct purchase to the State of Minnesota the parcel described as follows:

All of the following:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 103 North, Range 36 West, shown as Parcel 66 on Minnesota Department of Transportation Right of Way Plat Numbered 32-64 as the same is on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder in and for Jackson County, Minnesota;

containing 13879 square feet, more or less, which is encumbered in its entirety by an existing highway easement;

together with other rights as set forth below, forming and being part of said Parcel 66:

Temporary Easement:

A temporary easement for highway purposes as shown on said plat as to said Parcel 66 by the temporary easement symbol, said easement shall cease on December 1, 2027, or on such earlier date upon which the Commissioner of Transportation determines by formal order that it is no longer needed for highway purposes.

together with all hereditaments and appurtenances belonging thereto. Subject to mineral rights and utility easements of record, if any.
